4. 📄 **Working with current, authentic materials.**

It's helpful to stick with one tutor with whom you work well. But you'll encounter many different voices, accents, cadences, slang, and cultural norms in the real world. Incorporating authentic materials gives you that exposure while letting you stick with the tutor you love.

5. 🔄 **"Reviewing" your sessions.**

Repetition and review are key to learning, but it's hard to review a tutoring session per se. Your CL-150 tutor will provide regular notes on your gaps, weaknesses, and strengths, so you know which topics or concepts to review.
